

Caring Committee Responsibilities

The Caring Committee works in coordination with Pastor Larry MacKenzie to meet special needs primarily in our church family, but also in the community, as we are able. The majority of the aid we provide is as follows:

1. Arrange for and serve at funeral luncheons, see details below.
2. Provide financial aid as we become aware of the need and in coordination with Pastor Larry
3. Ensure the delivery of designated funds, when the giver wishes to remain anonymous.
4. Arrange for meals and/or special gift baskets, flowers, and casseroles at Christmas and in the spring. These go to those in our church family who are shut-ins, have recently been injured or seriously ill, recently widowed, and also the pastors' families and other church staff.

Funeral Food Details:

Piggly Wiggly (Pig order is charged to the funeral home)

1. Buns – mini Kaiser – call as soon as possible, ask for Ann or Eric when ordering
2. Ham – 4 lb. Farmland, sliced, ask for Nancy in meat dept. – 4 lbs usually fills about 50 small buns
3. Turkey – (only if family requests it) – order from Deli
4. Wheat buns (only if family requests it) – order from Deli

Woodmans

1. Scalloped potatoes – large box – serves 50
2. Butter – 2 lbs. for buns and potatoes, get 3 lbs. if getting 2 boxes of potatoes
3. Milk – 1 gallon of 1%
4. Coffee – small 50/50, sugar, creamer
5. Red Punch – mix together the following:
Red punch - large
2 liter 7 up
6. Small mayo

7. Small yellow mustard
8. Plates – Styrofoam
9. Cups
10. Napkins
